The supervisors signed EQIP contract for Todd Marsh's feedlot. Sod buster for Eric Simonson and other EQIP contracts for Jim Clark, Duane Ibsen, Chris Ator, Tim Holte, Tefre Farms and Rom Hedges.

MICKY McCALL

Mickey, Ryan, Joel put in moisture tubes on Smith's. They will install them on Orvis Nelson's. Mickey will talk to Roger Schmitz to see what his plans are for water management.

Mickey was at Orvis Nelson's for the aquifer test.

Mickey and Jon worked on the final report for grant RRG-00-1102.

Mickey worked on equipment to use on the Big Muddy.

Mickey and Jon met with the tribes in Poplar. Smoke creek will be sampled jointly. The Big Muddy will be sampled weekly in June and District will coordinate with the tribes to sample in July and August.

Mickey applied for another grant to reclaim old abandoned oil well sites.

NEW BUSINESS:

Grass Drill- Tim Holte will pull the drill home and fix it. The repairs will be charged to the District.

Rom made the motion to charge a \$250.00 deposit and make a check list to use between renters. Tim seconded. Carried.

WATER RESERVATION:

Kim Overcast with the water rights bureau (DNRC) stated the water hearing will be in early March. We will be applying for more water. We received a grant for legal services. Orvis Nelson's well pumped 850 gal. per minute. It was pumped for 72 hours. Data loggers were placed in a 10 mile radius showing very little draw down.

Tim moved to approve Orvis Nelson's applications SC-028. Kent seconded. Carried. A letter will be sent for Orvis to complete.
